



- The Yangon City Development Committee has initiated the modernizing its water supply system in Yangon City since August 2016. This project is under the Greater Yangon Urban Development project 2040 which is intended to meet the needs of the projected population in Yangon in the next 23 years, and will address key urban development issues such as drainage system, transportation, water and electricity.
- The World Bank has allocated US\$100 million to the Ayeyarwady-intergrated river basin management project (AIRBM), which focuses on capacity building, hydro-meteorological observation and information systems modernation.
- The National Water Resource Committee in Myanmar reports that over 91 percent of the available raw water resources is consumed by the agricultural sector, while domestic and industrial use accounts for 6 percent and 3 percent respectively. The trend over the next decade will see an increased usage from the domestic and industrial side.
- National statistics report that for the entire population of 52 million people in Myanmar, the required water for each person is 73 cubic meters per year. The available groundwater is 494.71 cubic kilometers and the available surface water is 1081.88 cubic kilometers


