Background

The National Water Resources Committee (NWRC) is an APEX body in Myanmar's Water Sector, chaired by the Vice President of Myanmar. The NWRC has three pillars namely the Secretariat, the Advisory Group (AG) and the Hydro-Informatics Centre (HIC). It is very important to groom young water professionals for the implementation of the Integrated Water Resources Management in Myanmar. The NWRC and AG are working on the long-term plan of producing the competent young water professional through HIC supported by the AG. Our vision is for long-term water security and sustainability to achieve Sustainable Development Goals by 2013. There is also an important task to implement the national Water Policy and the Water Law. The Young Water Professional Programme is a means to achieve this vision. The Ayeyarwady Integrated River Basin Management Project (AIRBM) Component 1 is responsible for the YWP programme, supported by the Government of Australia (through the Australian Water Partnership) and the Government of Netherlands. Water Aid Myanmar provides oversight of the YWP program financial management.

The Young Water Professional (YWP) program is a eleven month long program, in which young graduates of Myanmar who have ambition to become water professionals and government staff from various water related Ministries receive well defined technical and on job training through the Ayeyarwady Integrated River Basin Management (AIRBM) Project. They receive mentoring, coaching and training in various technical, social, economics, political and decision making aspects of water projects. YWP trainees are recruited across Myanmar and their trainings include lectures, seminars and field trips locally and abroad. Trainers include internationally well-known water professionals from all over the world and

from Myanmar. Members of Advisory Group of the National Water Resources Committee who are the most experienced water professionals of Myanmar will also give lectures to YWPs.

Required Qualification

- B.E. (Civil, Chemical, EC, Port & Harbor, River & Coastal, IT), B.Sc. (Computer Science & any science combination), LLB , B.Ag. , B.Sc. (Forestry) and Master’s degree in above subjects.
- Good English 4 skills
- Good computer skill in Microsoft Office (Excel, Word, Power Point, PDF)
- Age limit – maximum 30 years
- Must be able to travel locally and abroad if necessary.
