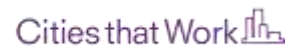

The Programme has identified **three integrated pillars** that will address key barriers to prosperity;

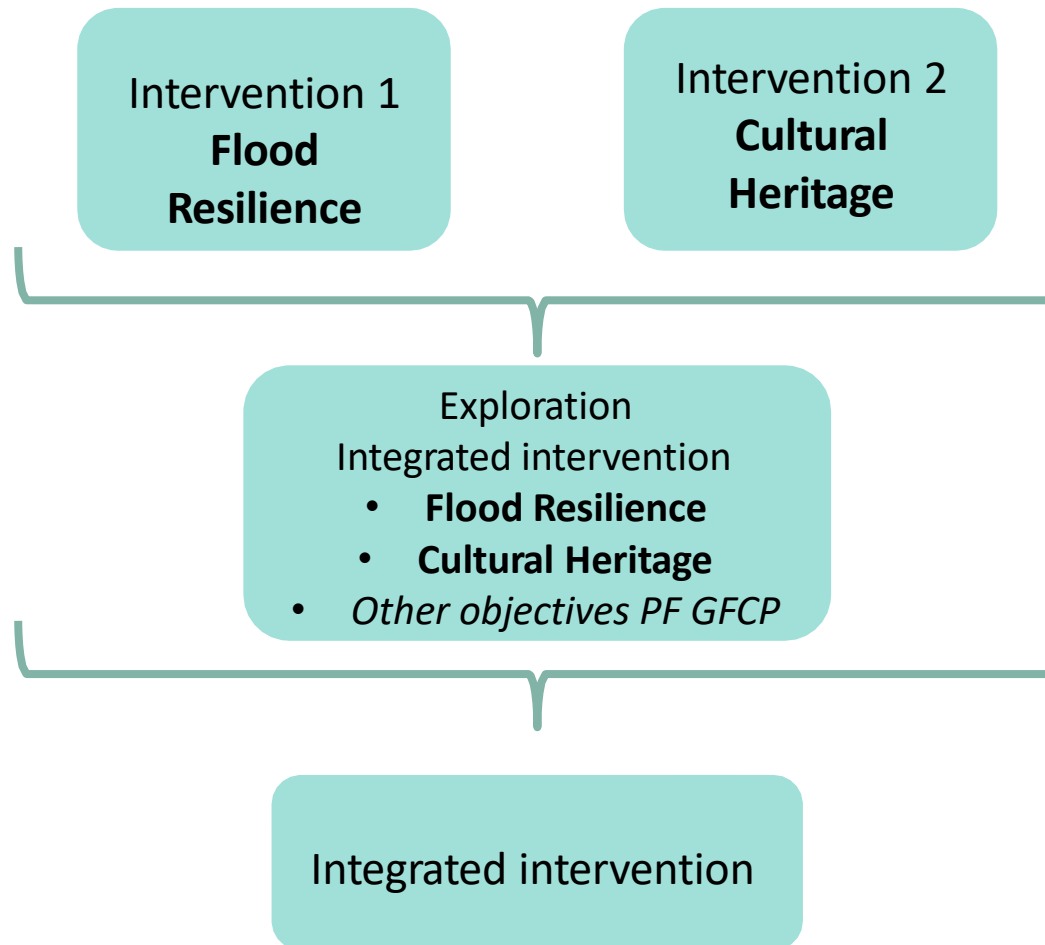
- (I) **Urban Planning**, to provide technical assistance for spatial restructuring;

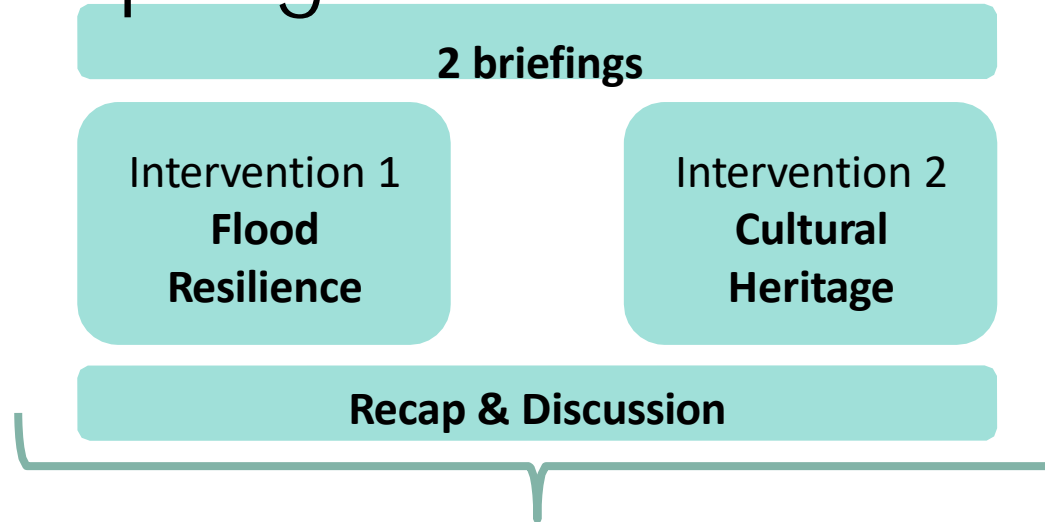

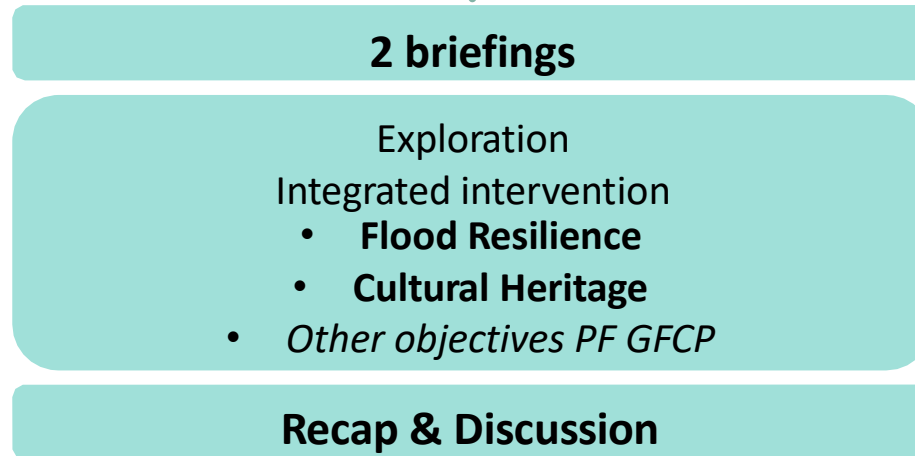
